TRIAL REGULATIONS – NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

POST DATED and RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**. **FOR FASTER ACKNOWLEDGEMENT** of acceptance please include your e-mail address or a self-addressed, stamped postcard with your entry form for the trial secretary to return.

FAXSIMILE, TELEPHONE, ELECTRONIC MAIL AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee, entry fees will not be refunded.

REFUNDS will not be given for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are absent or are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal.

BITCHES IN SEASON (shall not be eligible to participate) and INJURED DOGS: A veterinarian's note needs to accompany the request for a refund after the closing of the trial. Requests must be received prior to the date of trial. **An \$11.00 service fee/day will be charged.**

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS are the owner's responsibility and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

MOVE-UPS must be received by the secretary in writing or e-mail by Feb. 20, 2012 at 6 p.m. and by the end of the trial on Saturday for the Sunday classes.

DECLINATIONS OF ENTRIES: The Doberman Pinscher Club of Greater Milwaukee may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove dogs on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Doberman Pinscher Club of Greater Milwaukee.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to judging.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused.

DOGS PARTICIPATING must be fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

DOGS and CHILDREN AT THE TRIAL SITE must be in the control of their handler or parent. Any exhibitor whose dog or child engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the trial site. Puppies under six months of age are prohibited from the trial site. Pinch collars, citronella collars, electric and dummy electric collars, gentle leaders, and similar halter collars are prohibited on the trial site.

THE SAFETY OF THE DOGS is a primary concern of the Doberman Pinscher Club of Greater Milwaukee. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

DOBERMAN PINSCHER CLUB OF GREAT MILWAUKEE is not responsible for the loss of, injury to, or death of any dog exhibited, or the loss of or damage to any participant, whether the result of an accident or other cause.

A MAXIMUM of ten (10) dogs may be submitted per envelope for entries.

EXHIBITORS should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

NO RV OR OVERNIGHT PARKING AVAILABLE.

JUDGING TIME/COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

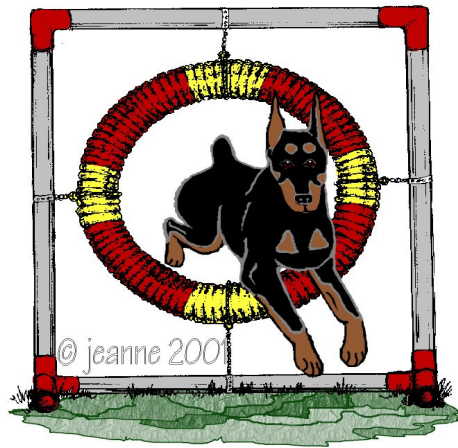
RIBBONS

A dark green qualifying ribbon will be given to each dog with a qualifying score. Ribbons will be awarded to the four top qualifiers in each height division in each class as follows:

First Place	Blue Ribbon
Second Place	Red Ribbon

A qualifying score is required for ALL prizes. "Dog" means either sex. Double Q and New Title rosettes will be available. Special MACH/PAX/PACH rosettes will be awarded to any dog earning a MACH/PAX/PACH title.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether the dog has a valid jump height card or if the dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include the dog entered on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that a copy of a dog's jump height card be submitted with an entry form or show it at check-in; although exhibitors are required to have the official form/card with them at the trial to present upon request.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
