

Thank you for your interest in membership in the Oshkosh Kennel Club.

The Oshkosh Kennel Club holds monthly meetings of the general membership on the second Wednesday of each month. Our meetings start at 7:00 pm with a program of interest to the membership and then a business meeting. In the past our programs have been things such as local veterinarians speaking on topics of importance to breeders and dog owners; speakers on various aspects of raising, training and showing dogs or representatives from AKC or other dog organizations. In the month of August we have our annual picnic in the place of the meeting and in December we have our annual awards banquet in place of the meeting.

The Oshkosh Kennel Club also sponsors yearly events such as our All-Breed Shows in January and May, Obedience Trials in January, July, October and December and Agility Trials in January, April and October. Training Classes run throughout the year with sessions lasting eight weeks.
