ACT1 is an entry level test that is open to all dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC Agility class and that meet the age and physical requirements for a regular AKC agility trial (Chapter 1, Section 3). Dogs must have two passing ACT1 scores in order to earn the ACT1 title. Both passing scores may be obtained under the same judge/evaluator. To receive the title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the AKC.

ACT2 is the second level Agility Course Test that is open to all dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC Agility class except an ACT1 title and that meet the age and physical requirements for a regular AKC agility trial (Chapter 1, Section 3). Dogs must have two passing ACT2 scores in order to earn the ACT2 title. Both passing scores may be obtained under the same judge/evaluator. To receive the title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the AKC. The ACT 2 title will supersede the ACT1 title on a dog's record. *(ACT 2 not offered at this event)*

- Each additional round of same dog (includes a \$5.00 AKC recording fee) \$15

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

For the ACT Program dogs may participate at any jump height determined by the owner. The following official AKC jump height table is for information only. There is no regular/preferred distinction at an ACT Event

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with

The American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

EQUIPMENT AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on Great Mats flooring. Ring size will be 68' x 121'.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all rounds are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during the specified walk-through period held prior to the start of the round. Due to space limitations, there will be no designated warm-up area, however exhibitors may use space outside of the ring to warm up dogs ahead of their run.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, and PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS –

- **Telegraph, Telephone, Fax, Email and unsigned entries cannot be accepted.** Entries not on official AKC entry forms, downloaded and/or photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.
- **Mail all entries with fees** to the Trial Secretary. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Confirmation via email will be made no later than 3 days before the trial. Should confirmation email not be received by the exhibitor within 3 days of the trial please contact the trial secretary.
- **Make all checks and money orders payable to Oshkosh Kennel Club** no credit or debit cards will be accepted for payment. Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. funds. The trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Tabulate carefully. Due to the cost of processing no refunds of \$4.00 and under will be made. An AKC recording fee of \$5.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club ACT Test. All recording and event service fees are paid to the AKC.
- **No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions** as to its acceptance—multiple entries made by one handler will be spaced day of the trial.
- **Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that** a dog is absent, disqualified, or judge or barred from competition by action of the event committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and dictates of law enforcement or the owners(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including but not limited to the condition of the facilities or grounds and /or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered to the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry will be made. - **Postdated checks, returned checks do not constitute valid entry.** If limits are met and your check is returned, the entry will be denied and that spot given to someone on the waitlist. If the trial is not full, the trial secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check of \$40 and entry must then be made with money order only and paid prior to the closing date.
- **An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from refunds for processed duplicate entries discovered after the closing date.** Every effort will be made to find and return duplicate entries before processing.
- **Errors on entry forms:** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, regardless of whomever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date.
- **Each Owner and handler listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog** at a show is bound by the certification and agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the entry form.
- **Evaluator will not wait for any dog holding up a class.** Owners and handlers are responsible for the presence of their dogs when their classes are called to be judged. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when running
- **All dog feces must be picked up, failure to do so will result in a trial committee hearing and excusal from the show grounds without refund of entry fees.**

- **BITCHES IN SEASON (shall not be eligible to participate) and INJURED DOGS:** A veterinarian's note needs to accompany the request for a refund after the closing of the trial. Requests must be received prior to the date of trial. **An \$5.00 service fee/day will be charged.**

IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Site notices

This is a dog training facility.

Being a popular and well-used training facility means it is subject to the smells and visual distractions inherent in such a facility. To the best of our ability, the ring areas are thoroughly cleaned and odors neutralized.

Dogs must be on leash at all times in and outside the facility unless running.

Only one dog will be permitted in the ring at any time.

Crating

Indoor Crating is limited. "Due to COVID, exact times will be designated for exhibitors to show up, but these times will not be determined until entry numbers are finalized. These times will be listed in the confirmation notice. You may crate and be in the building so long as social distancing is observed."

Communication

Please review the following **COVID requirements**. This is subject to change before or after closing date, you will be notified of any changes. You will also be required to sign a waiver electronically before final admission the show.

****If the trial is canceled, your entry fee will be refunded. We will destroy your check*****

1. If you have had COVID-19, you may not attend unless you have had a negative test. If you have been exposed to COVID-19, you may not attend within 14 days since exposure.
2. If you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 we request that you stay home. <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019ncov/symptoms-testing/symptoms.html>
3. **Masks must be worn at all times on the premises** (including in the ring) with the following exception: Masks may be removed under the privacy of your own shade tent / vehicle provided you are practicing proper social distancing from others. The judge will also be masked.
4. Exhibitors must bring their own mask. Masks will not be available.
5. Hand sanitizer and disinfectant will be available, but it is highly recommended that exhibitors bring their own.

6. Walkthroughs may be split to limit the number of people in the ring at one time. Please try to maintain a six-foot distance during all walk throughs. Masks must be worn during walkthroughs.
7. Check-in for your run with the gate steward – do not check yourself in. Check-in will be done verbally.
8. Upon entering the ring, leashes will be placed in a basket and the basket will be moved to the exit.
9. Exhibitors may NOT touch any equipment unless s/he is a worker.
10. There will be no hospitality (beverage and food will not be supplied or available to participants)
11. Failure to abide by these protocols will be grounds for immediate dismissal without a refund.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events. In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. AKC Canine PartnersSM applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results. Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
