MOVE-UP REGULATIONS:

If a dog earns an AKC agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition. **Written notice must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 6pm on Monday, February 18, 2024.** Day to day move-ups will be accepted if received **before the close of the trial Saturday, February 24, 2024**. Trial close will be considered the awarding of ribbons for the last class on that day. Move-ups will be added to the end of the running order of the class they move up to and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class.

Move-up form must be submitted—Verbal requests cannot be accepted. Fill out form and send to the Trial Secretary.

INFORMATION:

All classes will be held indoors on trac roll matting. Ring size is 68ft. x 121ft.

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the entire area clean. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dogs on the trial grounds will be excused from the trial with no entry fees refunded. Limited (2 Rows) of chair seating in the big room.

CRATING:

There will be limited, first come/first served indoor crating allowed. Dogs may not be left overnight. All crates inside the building must have ALL sides (including top) closed/zipped when not being attended to by the owner/handler.

FOOD: Food available for Workers only. Restaurants are located near-by. Soda, water, chips, etc available for purchase with all proceeds going to the UW-Madison Veterinary Scholarship

CATALOGS: Running orders will be posted online. Advanced catalog sales only--\$5.00. Please indicate on your entry form if you would like a catalog.

PRIZES AND AWARDS:

Ribbons will be awarded to First through Fourth place in each class and height division. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to those dogs receiving qualifying scores. New title ribbons, Double Q ribbons, MACH and PACH ribbons & bars will also be awarded. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Prizes must be claimed the day of the show—none will be mailed.

JUMP HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

REGULAR	PREFERRED	HEIGHT AT WITHERS
Dogs may run in a higher height division.	Dogs must run in proper eligible height.	Owners are responsible for entering their dog in the proper height division.
8"	4"	For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers
12"	8"	For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
16"	12"	For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers

24C"	n/a	Dogs measuring 22 inches and under at the withers may enter the 24-Choice height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-Choice.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day:

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

If a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

HEIGHT CARD REQUIREMENT:

When filling out the entry form, please designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the list of dogs to be measured. If a measurement is necessary, it is solely the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Exhibitors should have their dog's original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form available at each trial to present upon request. **Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.**

OBSTACLES:

Obstacles will meet the specifications in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP0 or an AKC Canine partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service(FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs disfigured as the result of accident or injury but otherwise qualified shall be eligible provided that the disfigurement does not interfere with functional movement. Dogs should be physically sound... Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible. Blind means without useful vision. No dog shall

compete if it is taped or bandaged or in any way has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Deaf dogs are eligible to participate.

Females in season shall not be eligible to participate. Entry fees for females in season must be refunded per Chapter 1, Section 9.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

REFUNDS:

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Entry fee for bitches that come into season or a dog that is injured after the closing date will be refunded (less \$10 administrative fee per day) if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary 30 minutes prior to the start of judging

RINGSIDE:

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your turn and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

SAFETY AND BEHAVIOR:

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
