AKC AGILITY MOVE-UP FORM

However, *written notice must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 6 pm on Monday, April 20, 2026.* Day to day move-ups will be accepted if received *before the close of the trial Friday, April 24, 2026 or Saturday, April 25, 2026.* Trial close will be considered to be the awarding of ribbons for the last class on that day. Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class. Verbal requests cannot be accepted.

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during a run.

FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

FEO is allowed in all classes at this trial. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying. FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any *jump height* for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show *jump height* changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any *level* of STD, JWW and/or FAST. If dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show *level* changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible. Toys may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely cannot be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time
- Handler has 45 seconds for Standard, JWW and Time 2 Beat classes, or course time in FAST. Exhibitors must move quickly toward the exist when the horn sounds.

REFUNDS No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Entry fee for bitches that come into season or a dog that is injured after the closing date will be refunded (less \$12 administrative fee per day) if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary 30 minutes prior to the start of judging.

RINGSIDE Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your turn and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

SAFETY The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulation and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

The AKC is committed to creating a safe and respectful sport environment for all. If you need to talk to someone, or need help, please call 800. 656.HOPE (National Sexual Assault Hotline) or text HOME to 741-741 for free, 24/7, confidential services from trained crisis counselors.

LIABILITY It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Timber Ridge Obedience Club of Central Wisconsin, Oshkosh Kennel Club, Bluestem Agility Trial Services, LLC, and their members, agents, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

RESPONSIBILITIES: All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when at the outdoor practice jump. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the entire area clean. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dogs on the trial grounds will be excused from the trial with no entry fees refunded.

SEATING: Seating is available ringside. No oversized chairs, reclining chairs, or tables in this area please. No dogs in the front row please.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

SITE INFORMATION

OSHKOSH KENNEL CLUB 220 W Packer Avenue, Oshkosh WI 54901

Trial will be indoors on stall matting. Ring size is 68ft. x 121ft. All obstacles meet the specifications in the current edition of *Regulations for Agility Trials*.

PARKING Please park as efficiently as possible in the gravel lot east of the building. On-street parking is allowed on the north side of W Packer Avenue on Saturday and Sunday **only**; **NO** on-street parking allowed on Friday. **NO** parking on grass. **NO parking allowed on the Oshkosh Auto Works property.**

RV and/or overnight parking available on the gravel parking lot only. Overnight parking \$10 per night; No electrical hookups. The City of Oshkosh will ticket all overnight parking on the blacktop lot.

CRATING Limited indoor crating is available. Chairs may not be allowed in the crating room if space is tight. Crating in the main room adjacent to the office is reserved for volunteers only. Please conserve space when crating to allow all competitors room to crate their dogs. X-pens and oversized chairs are not allowed. Crates may be left overnight, however, the Timber Ridge Obedience Club of Central WI, Oshkosh Kennel Club, and Bluestem Agility Trial Services, LLC will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. Dogs may not be left overnight. Crates must have ALL sides (including top) closed/zipped when not being attended to by the owner/handler.

FOOD Rodney's Cafe will be on site all three days for food purchases. No alcoholic beverages permitted on grounds.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From the north: HWY 41 south to exit for Ryf Rd. At stop sign turn left onto HWY-H. Take first right onto Stearns Dr. Take first left onto W. Snell Rd. At traffic light turn right onto Jackson St. Go about 1.3 miles, then turn left onto West Packer Ave. The OKC clubhouse is on the left.

From the south: HWY 41 north to exit 119 east onto Oshkosh Ave/WIS-21. Go 1.2 miles then turn left onto Elmwood Ave. Go 0.3 miles and turn right onto W Murdock Ave. Go 0.5 miles and take the third exit at the roundabout onto Jackson St. heading north. Go 0.7 miles and turn right onto West Packer Ave. The OKC clubhouse is on the left.

HEIGHT CARD REQUIREMENT:

When filling out the entry form, please designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the list of dogs to be measured. If a measurement is necessary, it is solely the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Exhibitors should have their dog's original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form available at each trial to present upon request. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.*

PRIZES AND AWARDS:

Ribbons will be awarded to First through Fourth place in each class and height division. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to those dogs receiving qualifying scores. New title ribbons, Double Q ribbons, Triple Q ribbons, MACH and PACH rosettes and bars will also be awarded. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Prizes must be claimed the day of the show; none will be mailed.

ENTERING A MIXTURE of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend or Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. If a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20" Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C" Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
